- discuss his experience and future vision for how AI and ML will continue to impact behavioral health care reimbursement over the next 5-10 years.
- In March, to learn more about the Recovery Capital Index (RCI), Eric connected with Alliance participant and architect of the RCI, David Whitesock of Commonly Well, a behavioral health analytics and care experience firm. Specifically, I focused our conversation on how the RCI came to fruition and the value that it has demonstrated to organizations that are committed to personcentered outcomes in substance use disorder (SUD) treatment.
- In May, to learn more about behavioral health VBP adoption from payer organization perspectives, Eric connected with Alliance for Addiction Payment Reform (Alliance) participant Jessica Kelley, J.D., M.H.A. of the Association for Behavioral Health and Wellness (ABHW), a leading association working to advance federal policy and mental health (MH) and SUD services. Specifically, I focused our conversation on how participating ABHW members have been adopting VBPs and APMs and where they have experienced success/challenges.
- In July, to learn more about the power of transparency in coverage data available through commercial health plan machinereadable files, Eric connected with Cheryl Matochik, Third Horizon Strategies Managing Director for Market Analytics. Specifically, I focused our conversation on how providers can proactively leverage the transparency in coverage rate data to negotiate alternative payment arrangements with commercial health plans in various markets.
- In September, to learn more about the potential impact of Peer Recovery Support Services (PRSS) on the total cost of care within health care, Eric connected with Alliance participant Dr. Sierra Castedo de Martell, Assistant Research Scientist with the JEAP Initiative at Chestnut Health Systems' Lighthouse Institute to discuss her work in

- researching the financial impact of PRSS on total cost of healthcare, culminating in the creation of a cost-effectiveness calculator for peer recovery support services and for bystander naloxone distribution and a forthcoming journal article reporting the results of a cost-effectiveness analysis of PRSS (Castedo de Martell et al., under review).
- In November, Eric connected with Shauna Goodman, executive director at the National Sobering Collaborative, to learn more about the role sobering centers play with respect to enhancing the SUD service delivery system through a harm-reduction and public health approach.
- Throughout 2024, Eric, Ashley, and Greg from TH have represented the Alliance in numerous webinars, educational sessions/publications, and client engagements tied to addiction payment reform.
